The public and education access channels are available on Charter Spectrum Cable Channels 989 and 990, along with the content placed on [facebook.com/marshfieldmediaaccess](https://www.facebook.com/marshfieldmediaaccess) and the City website ci.marshfield.wi.us.

MFLD Media Access staff will not only provide local government information regarding City events and news on our government Charter Spectrum Cable Channel 991, but also leverage our two public access channels 989 and 990 and its online resources with volunteers to help get information using multimedia.

We are looking for volunteers to help film and take photos at community events, provide graphic design for event listings, reporting, video editing, down to delivery of this newsletter to shut-ins.
