

Plaza receives "Great Places in Wisconsin" award



The Wenzel Family Plaza recently received a "Great Places" award at a recent APA (American Planning Association) fall conference in Eau Claire. The award celebrates the hard work and tough choices of elected officials, City of Marshfield's Development Services Department, Wenzel Family Plaza Committee and dozens of community members. APA's Great Places is an opportunity to highlight and celebrate examples of great public spaces in communities around the state. The nominations were judged by a jury of professional planners from Minnesota and confirmed by the APA-Wisconsin Chapter Board of Directors.



Nicki Ryner, Wenzel Family Plaza Coordinator, said at a recent Common Council meeting in October, the plaza hosted 70 events from May - Sept, with over 5000 visitors attending the events. Ryner said, "The Plaza will continue to focus to help increase foot traffic downtown and provide a place for local businesses to hold events." The Plaza also earned a Wisconsin Main Street awarded earlier in 2019 as the Plaza Best Public Improvement Project. Watch Ryner's presentation on the City of Marshfield's YouTube Channel.

The Wenzel Family Plaza is a public space located in downtown Marshfield where events are held year-around. Planning started years ago when the City identified a need for a community-gathering place in its downtown master planning process. Construction on the Plaza began in September 2017 and a grand opening was held on Wednesday, July 11, 2018.

Wenzel Family Plaza was developed on the former Marshfield News-Herald property along West Third Street. It includes a performance stage, a fountain, tables and chairs for dining, plants/trees, and a shaded seating area.
