
City of Marshfield Walk/Bike to School Challenge for 2019!

October is Walk to School Month and it's time for the annual Walk/Bike to School Challenge. The City of Marshfield, as part of the Safe Routes to School program, will hold a walk/bike to school contest in conjunction with International Walk to School Day. Students in grades K-6 are encouraged to participate. **Due to generous donations from Marshfield Clinic Health System, Nasonville Dairy, and several private donors we will be giving away gift certificates towards 14 new bikes (two per participating school):** Grant, Lincoln, Madison, Nasonville, Washington, Immanuel Lutheran, and Columbus Catholic Schools.

Contest

- **Open to students grades K-6 in Marshfield Schools.**
 - Students are encouraged to **walk or bike to school during October.**
 - Starts **Tuesday, October 1, 2019** and concludes **Thursday, October 31, 2019.**
 - Students can walk or bike to school **from home or nearby drop-off points.**
 - **Only school days** will be counted to determine prize eligibility.
 - Participating students will be **entered into a prize drawing.**
 - **Bussed students or those unable to walk or bike to school (even due to weather)** can participate in **alternative activities** as determined by their parents, teachers, or schools.
 - **Teachers can track student's participation** using spreadsheets provided.
 - Walk to School Day, Wednesday, October 2nd, will be counted as two participation days.
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Prizes

Students that walk or bike to school...

- **20+** • **20 days +** will be entered in a drawing to win a **\$350 GIFT CERTIFICATE** from the Sports Den towards the purchase of a **NEW BIKE!**
- **15+** • **15 days +** will be entered in a drawing to win a **BIKE HELMET!**
- **10+** • **10 days +** will be entered in a drawing to win a **T-SHIRT!**

Prize eligibility is based on participation. Not all participants are guaranteed a prize. Quantities for prizes are limited. Some bicycles were donated to the program, so we encourage winners to select one of those bicycles first, if possible.
