Special Notes: This policy/procedure manual does not in any way constitute an employment contract and the City of Marshfield reserves the right to amend this manual at any time subject only to approval by the Common Council.

There shall be a Board of Public Works Policy governing culvert endwalls on driveway and private entrances.

1. The Board of Public Works does not recognize the use of permanent concrete endwalls at the ends of driveway culverts. If the City removed said endwalls for any reason (Example - re-alignment of ditch grades) the endwalls will not be replaced by the City.
2. If the landowner and/or resident desires to use endwalls constructed of concrete, asphalt, wood posts, brick, fieldstone or other long life materials, he shall do so at the risk of removal by the City for any reason as stated in paragraph 1.
3. Height of any endwalls shall not exceed that of the top of the driveway for the protection of City snowplows if constructed by landowners and/or residents.
