



Animal Enrichment Education Program

Have you always wondered what enrichment is and why it is so important? Our zookeepers would love to teach you! Enrichment is something that targets an animal's senses of smell, taste, touch, sight & hearing, and also pulls forth their natural behaviors. Animals under human care need enrichment to be happy & healthy, both mentally and physically. If you book one of our Animal Enrichment Education Programs, you will have the opportunity to help create new enrichment and watch the animal of your choosing interact with your creation! In this tour, we will utilize perfumes, spices, and extracts to demonstrate the power of smell as enrichment!

A maximum of 30 people per presentation, please. *The cost for each program is \$200 per group with a maximum of 30 people, or \$10 per person with a minimum of 4 people.
