Youth gymnastics classes will begin Monday, November 4th for ages 3 1/2 and up. Classes will be held for five weeks at the Marshfield Senior High Fieldhouse gymnastics area. The cost is \$25.00 for city residents and \$37.50 for non-residents.

Did you know?

Beginning Tuesday, September 3, 2019 the northbound outside lane will be closed to traffic on North Oak Avenue between Ives Street and Upham Street. This lane closure is necessary for the completion of the Wildwood McMillan Connector Trail Project.

This closure is expected to last approximately two months.
