Welcome Home Ambulance No. 95

The Marshfield Fire and Rescue Department welcomes home Ambulance 95. The ambulance built on a 2019 Ford 550 chassis by Braun Custom Ambulances is the newest in the fleet of five Advanced Life Support (ALS) ambulances. In addition to the larger carrying capacity, the ambulance is also the first four-wheel drive ambulance for the department. And another unique feature of the ambulance is the liquid springs for the rear suspension, giving this vehicle a better ride for patients and crew.



Marshfield Fire and Rescue Department Deputy Chief Steve Bakos started the process in 2018 along with a committee to determine the needs for the future. The department awarded the bid to Braun Custom Ambulances in early part of 2019 and was recently finished and put in service.

As a cost savings measure for the department they decided not to sell off their oldest ambulance in the fleet, but instead keep it in service. Bakos said, every three years the department would replace the oldest ambulance in the fleet, but now are planning on a five year rotation. "I budgeted \$215,000 for this ambulance and the unit came in a little over \$205,000, and we expect this ambulance to last 15 years. Realistically, the \$205,000 is not inclusive of the ambulance but some very expensive equipment and supplies need to be mounted in the ambulance too," said Bakos.



Inside the ambulance, the crew has the latest in life support devices and a much larger work space for the paramedics. The ambulance is a Type 1 ambulance, which means the ambulance is mounted on a truck-style chassis and the driver compartment resembles a pickup truck. The connection between the cab and patient module is a small window, and the other four ambulances in the fleet are Type 3, which are mounted on a cutaway van chassis. The cab is an integral part of the Type 3 ambulances, which allows for a connection between the driver, paramedic and patient.

Marshfield Fire and Rescue Department not only services the city of Marshfield, but also has contracts with 13 townships and villages, mutual aid agreements, internal transfers for Marshfield Medical Center and paramedic intercepts.

This is the second Braun Ambulance they now have in service, (Ambulance 95 and 99) along with an AEV (Ambulance 96), a Medtec (Ambulance 97) and a Marque (Ambulance 98).

The Community Center is available to everyone ages 50 and older and no membership is required. The Center features different activities and programs held throughout the year.


Bingo - Tuesdays at 1:00 p.m. on the second Friday of each month.
