

Currently, over 50 families have made a pledge of \$1000.00 or more. The first 100 families will have the opportunity to be recognized on the Family Gathering Shelter and be the last group to jump into Hefko Pool for a summer party in 2020. As of November 15, we have secured approximately \$750,000 in pledge donations.
