### Assessor's Office sending out notices of change

The City of Marshfield Assessor's Office is sending out notices of change to residential and commercial owners the week of February 11, 2020. The purpose of property valuations are to provide for the uniform and fair distribution of the property tax

burden. Under the authority of Wisconsin Law, the City of Marshfield Assessor must discover, list, and value all taxable property within the city limits on an annual basis, which was done as of January 1, 2020.



Each year the Assessor's Office provides an opportunity for property owners to discuss their values during meetings known as "Open Book". This year's "Open Book" will take place on Tuesday, March 24, 2020, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. in the Public Conference Room at City Hall. A copy of assessment rolls are available during this time and there will also be copies of the rolls at the Public Library from March 19-23, 2020. To speak to the assessor on March 24, please contact City of Marshfield Assessor's Office to setup an appointment at 715-384-3856 or e-mail at Keith.Pugh@ci.marshfield.wi.us.

Following the "Open Book" a Board of Review will be held at City Hall in the Council Chambers on Wednesday, May 20, 2020. In order to appear at the Board of Review, you must notify the City of Marshfield's Clerk's Office in writing not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the meeting. Once notified, the clerk will make an appointment time for you to be heard. A properly completed objection form must be presented to the clerk prior to the hearing.
