Property taxes due January 31, 2020



Tax bills were recently mailed to property owners in the city which means property taxes must be paid on or before the last day of January.

There are two options available to property owners to pay their bills. If the two-payment plan is chosen, the first payment must be made by January 31, 2020, and the second payment must be made to the applicable County Treasurer between February 1 and July 31, 2020 to avoid penalty. The two-payment plan cannot be used if the tax bill is \$99.99 or less.

If taxes are not paid by January, 31 2020, the tax is declared delinquent and interest is charged at the rate of 1% per month starting with the preceding February 1, 2020.
