The Common Council voted 8-1 for a temporary eastbound one-way street, with angled parking on East Second Street between Maple Avenue and Cedar Avenue for two months or until the first snowfall, whichever comes first.

Beginning Monday, September 16, the City will begin the project, so please be mindful of our City staff working in that area. These temporary changes are being done to gauge the need for additional parking adjacent to the Everett Roehl Marshfield Public Library and Community Center.

A survey to gauge public opinion of the one-way street and angled parking is located in the Library at the information desk and in the Community Center at the Parks and Recreation office. Upon completion of the temporary one-way street City staff will put together the results of the surveys and bring a recommendation to the Board of Public Works this winter for consideration.
