 - Sportsmanship / Team Play

 - Players
 - Coaches
 - Referees
 - Parents



Player Considerations

- Equal playing time (50%)
- Experience all playing positions (goalkeeper optional)
- SAFETY is #1 consideration
 - Rough/Dangerous Play
 - Weather
 - Dehydration







Laws of the Game-Addendum's

- Law 2 -- The Ball
 - K-1st grade: Size 3
 - 2nd -3rd grade: Size 4
 - 4th – 6th grade: Size 4



Laws of the Game-Addendum's

- Law 3 -- Number of Players
- Format for
 - K – 1st : 4V4 no GK
 - 2nd – 3rd : 6V6 w/GK
 - 4th – 6th : 8V8 or 9V9 w/GK
 - Tactical Coaching
 - From the bench
 - No parents



Substitutions

- Substitutions - All with referee approval
- **K-1st grade:** “Clear the bench” every 5 minutes
- Rotate players

Laws of the Game-Addendum's

- Law 4 -- Player's Equipment
 - Shin guards
 - No metal cleats
 - Goalkeeper jersey
- Law 5 -- The Referee
 - All ages: High School and Middle School soccer players , some may not be USSF certified
- Law 6 -- Assistant Referee's



Laws of the Game-Addendum's

- Law 7 -- Duration of the Match
 - K-1st grade: 2 x 15-min halves (5 min)
 - 2nd – 3rd grade: 2 x 25-min halves (5 min)
 - 4th – 6th grade: 2 x 30-min halves (5 min)
- Law 8 -- Starts and Restarts
 - K – 1st grade: 6 yards from center
 - 2nd – 3rd grade/ 4th - 6th : 10 yards from center
 - Dropped Ball procedure



Laws of the Game-Addendum's

- Law 9 -- Ball In and Out of Play
 - Play stopped for ALL injuries (Field Coordinator will have First Aid kit)
 - Diagrams of ball out of play






Laws of the Game-Addendum's

- Law 11 -- Offside
 - K – 1st grade: No offside/No goalkeepers
 - 2nd -3rd grade: No offside/No cherry picking
 - 4th – 6th grade: Offside
 - At the time the ball is kicked ...
 - Two defensive players between ball and goal
 - Offside position vs. Offside call (Area of Activity)








Even With Last Defender










Rebound Off Goal






Rebound Off Goal





Offsides Position/Not Called






Offsides Position/Not Called

Laws of the Game-Addendum's

- Law 12 -- Fouls and Misconducts
 - K-1st grade:
 - All fouls are *indirect kick*
 - Opponents 6 yards from ball
 - Coaches / Referees explain all infractions
 - No Yellow or Red cards, except by field coordinator
 - Player can be ejected for parental conduct



Fouls and Misconduct

- **Yellow Card**

- Dissent
- Unsporting Conduct
- Delay of Game
- Distance Infractions
- Infringement of Laws
- Entering field w/o ref
- Leaving field w/o ref

- **Red Card**

- Violent Conduct
- Handling (goal opportunity)
- Serious Foul Play
- Cautionable offense x 2
- Offensive Language
- Penal Foul (goal opportunity)
- Spitting



No Slide Tackling

- **No Slide Tackling Rule follows USYSA rule for rec soccer.**
- At all levels, the ‘field players’ **MAY NOT** leave their feet to play, or attempt to play, the ball with the exception of heading the ball.
- Therefore, slide tackles, slide blocks, slide shots and ‘bicycles’ will be whistled as a direct free kick foul.



Penal Fouls-Indirect Kick



- Goalkeeper
 - Longer than 6 seconds
 - Handling, after release
 - Kickback
 - Handling from throw-in
- Dangerous Play
- Impeding the Progress
- Preventing GK from releasing ball w/ hands
- Play is stopped (non-penal)
- Offside



Laws of the Game-Addendum's

- Law 13 -- Free Kicks
 - K-1st grade: No direct Kicks
 - 2nd – 3rd grade and 4th – 6th grade:
 - FIFA: Point of Infringement/stationary ball/10 yards
- Law 14 -- The Penalty Kick
 - No PK for K-1st grade
 - 2nd – 3rd grade and 4th – 6th :
 - Penal fouls inside the penalty area
 - 10 yards from ball during PK



Laws of the Game-Addendum's

- Law 15 -- The Throw-In
 - Technique of Throw-In
 - K – 1st and 2nd – 3rd grades: Second throw-in allowed, with instruction by referee
 - 4th – 6th : Bad throw = change in possession
- Law 16 -- The Goal Kick
 - Taken any point within the goal area
- Law 17 -- The Corner Kick
 - Nearest corner
