Brenda Hanson presented the Machinery & Equipment Rate Study and proposed rates for 2008. Alderman Kraus requested that approval of the rates be delayed two weeks to allow for more detailed review of those pieces of equipment that may not be paying for themselves.

<u>PW07-82</u> Motion by Feirer, second by Krueger to recommend approval of Resolution No. 2007-36 and 2007-37 regarding Machinery & Equipment Rates and refer to the Common Council for consideration with a review of equipment to be scheduled as soon as possible.

Kraus voted 'No', Wagner, Hansen, Krueger and Feirer voted 'Aye' Motion Carried

<u>PW07-83</u> Motion by Kraus, second by Feirer to recommend approval of a contract extension with Nikolay Transport Co., Inc. of Marshfield, WI for snow and ice removal in 11 municipal parking lots until May 15, 2008 with no increase to the 2007 rates.

PW07-84 Motion by Feirer, second by Kraus to recommend approval of Board of Public Works Resolution No. 01-2007 which requires unsafe and defective sidewalk at various locations in the City, identified in Attachment 'A;, to be repaired or replaced, and authorize the City Engineer to send notice to the property owners.

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City Engineer Turchi and Street Superintendent Panzer presented an update to the Board of Public Works regarding 2007 construction projects.

Kurt Schoen, Earth Tech presented information regarding storm water quality comparisons between streets with ditches and streets with curb and gutter. Ditched streets provide storm water quality benefits by allowing storm water to infiltrate into subsurface soils. Storm water quality improvements are achieved on curb and gutter streets from either catch basin cleaning or street sweeping, but not both. In general terms, similar storm water quality benefits can be achieved with ditches or regular street sweeping on curb and gutter streets.
