The application that was submitted by Burrachos LLC for a Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverage license was held over. The Planning and Economic Development department is working with this company and asked for this item to be held over until the issues have been resolved.

Gladys Martin filed a claim with the City alleging that her vehicle sustained damage to the tire after striking a pothole located on Maple Avenue on June 6, 2006. The claim was filed with the City's insurance company, Midwest Claims Service. They have completed their investigation and are recommending that the City of Marshfield deny this claim.

The basis of the denial is that there is no negligence on behalf of the City. The City did not have prior notice of this particular pothole being in the roadway and upon the claimant's notice; the street department responded in a reasonable amount of time but could not find any potholes in the area. A municipality has no liability unless it knew, or should have known, of the existence of a defect and had a reasonable amount of time to repair the defect.

<u>JLC06-064</u> Motion by Wagner, second by Krueger to deny the claim of Gladys Martin pursuant to the Wisconsin statute for disallowance of claim 893.80 (1g). The basis of the denial is that there was no negligence on behalf of the City of Marshfield. All Ayes
