The basis of the denial is due to the fact that there is not enough evidence to prove that the damage to the claimant's vehicle was due to any ice thrown from the City's loader truck. Additionally the crew that was working on this project does not recall any such incident. Based on the lack of evidence it is difficult to determine whether the City would be liable for these damages.
