Project Update Discussed.

- A. The 320' Proposed tower in Nasonville by WE Energies will be reduced in height. It will no longer affect the minimums into the Marshfield Airport. This is in thanks to all the businesses and pilots who wrote to the Federal Aviation Administration to complain about the tower height affecting the airport.
- B. Several airports from around the State of Wisconsin have provided images of their airport signs.
- C. We have received about a dozen emails from airports around the state saying that they do not clean the three feet in front of a privately owned hangar. This all came about when one airport asked how other airports handle the snow in front of privately owned hangars. Typically here at Marshfield we leave about a foot in front of privately owned hangars.
- D. A letter has been sent to the local townships surrounding Marshfield to let them know we are more than willing to help them in they need our assistance dealing with a tower or tall object. A copy is included in your packet.
