PUBLIC HEARING – 7:00 PM

1. Request from Norbert Dittner for a zoning change to 'R-4' Residential (Low Density Single and Two Family District) for the part of a proposed 2.22 acre lot currently zoned 'A' (Agricultural Holding District), located on the north side of STH 13 and on the west side of Frey Avenue.

because he has sold the property

2. Conditional use request from Muhammad Bakr Ghbeis and Alaa Tello for a home occupation at 510 West Ives Street, zoned 'R-4' Low Density Single and Two Family Residential District.

FOR: None

AGAINST: Shirley Pritzl, 504 West Ives Street, questioned exactly why and what they intend to do with the conditional use permit. Planner/Zoning Administrator Curtiss summarized the nature of the request. Mrs. Pritzl is concerned with how many cars would be coming and going and feels there is the potential for blocking of driveways. She has no objection to the request but doesn't want to be inconvenienced by it.

3. Proposed Project Plan and District Boundary for the creation of Tax Incremental Finance District (TID) No. 8.

Steve Schulte, M220 Sugarbush Lane, stated that he is not in favor of or against the request. He stated that he has served on the Marshfield School Board for the last 22 years. He is not representing the School District tonight but believes that the School District would share his concerns. During the last School District referendum, numbers were crunched and the taxpayers were told that the School District's share of the tax bill would go down. When the tax bills came out, the School District's share actually increased. Taxes went up not because of decisions of the School Board but because of TIF districts. He is asking for truth in taxation regarding TIF charges and is asking the Plan Commission to consider two things:

- 1. Identify cost to taxpayers for \$100,000 home for TIF districts.
- 2. Show the value of TIF taxes on the annual property tax bill.
