<u>PC06-74</u> Motion by Meyer, second by Wolf to recommend approval of the master sign plan for "Century Plaza II" located at 1613-1641 North Central Avenue subject to the following:

- Tenant wall signs shall be limited to one (1) per tenant space, installed on the mansard area and centered over the storefront.
- All future tenant spaces with less than 25 LF of frontage will be allowed 50 SF maximum wall signs and tenant spaces with more than 25 LF of frontage will be allowed 2 SF of wall signs per LF of frontage.
- Future tenant wall signs shall either be internally-lit channel form letters on raceways or internally-lit cabinet signs.
- A non-conforming sign permit application shall be filed for the multi-tenant pylon sign,
- Within five years, owners shall propose an update to Master Sign plan that would address non-conformity of multi-tenant pylon sign.
