Marshfield Fire and Rescue's Citizen Fire

Academy . . . is a program designed to help citizens become more familiar and involved with the services provided by the fire service.

This five-week course is not designed to train future fire fighters, rather for citizens who are interested in gaining an insider's view of the services Marshfield Fire & Rescue Department provides while also acquiring fire and emergency medical safety skills you can use in everyday life.

The CFA curriculum is divided into three areas: classroom participation, hands-on practical experiences, and drill-ground activities. Citizens are not required to participate in any activity in which they do not feel comfortable.

Through these experiences, Marshfield Fire and Rescue hopes citizens and the community will have a better understanding of the fire service.



Are you ready for the challenge?

What: Planning is underway for a Citizens Fire Academy (CFA) this summer. Applications are being accepted for the academy and participants will be notified of the exact dates once they are accepted.

Who: Citizens of Marshfield who are age 18 or older.

When: The Citizen Fire Academy will meet one night a week from 6:00-9:00 p.m. for five weeks.

Where: Marshfield Fire and Rescue Department, 514 E. 4th Street, Marshfield, Wisconsin

Why: It is our desire to increase awareness about the Fire Department with our local residents, so that these residents will become well-informed citizens who can become more involved with the long-term safety of our community.

Cost: Free

Class Size: Limited to 12 Applicants

All applicants will be evaluated for participation following the completion of a release form and background check.

- Fire Extinguishers
- Search and Rescue Techniques
- Fire Ground Operations
