5. Conditions

- Applicant shall contact Digger's Hotline for utility locates and shall arrange to have private service laterals located.
- All monitoring wells shall be flush mount, level with the adjacent area. Wells placed in pavement must be restored with concrete.
- Upon abandonment of the wells, the area shall be restored to the pre-well condition.
- If discharge water from bailing or sampling is to be disposed of locally, disposal shall be coordinated with the Wastewater Superintendent.
- Applicant shall be responsible for all costs associated with permitted activity, including abandonments and site restoration. Applicant agrees that if site restoration is not completed satisfactorily, the City may elect to complete restoration and applicant will reimburse the City for costs incurred.
- Applicant shall provide, place and maintain all traffic control devices required to accommodate the permitted activity. Traffic control shall be in accordance with the standards and guidelines from Part 6 "Temporary Traffic Control" of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). Traffic control shall be subject to review by the City Engineer.
- Applicant shall provide a map, with measurements to nearby landmarks, showing "as installed" locations of permanent wells.
- Applicant agrees to defend, indemnify and hold the City of Marshfield and its employees harmless from and against any and all liabilities, losses, claims, suits, judgments, damages, costs and expenses including reasonable attorney's fees and costs, for injury, death or damages to persons, personal property or improvements on real property that the City or its employees may hereafter suffer in connection with or arising from negligent acts or omissions by applicant or applicant's subcontractors associated with the aforementioned activity.
- Applicant shall provide the City with a minimum of three working days advanced notice of the dates on which the work will take place.
