



Wisconsin Frog and Toad-call Program

Every spring, our local area is filled with the chorus of frogs & toads! Not only can we identify these animals by their calls, but they serve an important role within many ecosystems. You will learn frog calls and identification techniques during this 60-minute program. Additional hands-on group activities are available if scheduled in advance.

This program is available from April through June. Program must be scheduled at least **one week** in advance. Max of 30 people per program, please.



This program includes:

- A lesson plan containing components of background information on local species of frogs and toads in Wisconsin.
- An interactive program on Wisconsin frogs and toads.
- Tour of our Zoo trail system where kids will listen to and identify different seasonal amphibians calling.
